Rosé, Millésime 2023 IGP Coteaux du Pont du Gard

Grape varieties:

75 % Cinsault 25% Caladoc 75cl

Wine-making:

Traditional wine-making which reveals all the aromas. Cinsault is the typical grape variety of the Mediterranean rosé, light and generous at the same time.

Tasting:

Beautiful salmon pink colour. A nose of white flowers, typical of Cinsault.

Round and generous on the palate, with aromas of ripe strawberries.

Food pairing:

Drink it as an aperitif. A perfect match to southern cuisine, this cuvée goes well with summer dishes such as gazpacho, salads or couscous.

Serve at: 8-10° C Cellaring: 1 year
